An Overview of Our Performance

Highlights

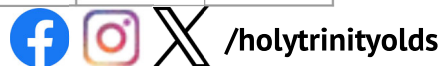
We are proud that Holy Trinity Catholic School continues to rank above the provincial averages in all Assurance Measures categories and that we have shown improvement from our previous year's results. Specific areas of celebration include:

- Parental Involvement score sits at 12.8% above the provincial norm a result of administration's priorities to seek parental feedback in the form of surveys and through school council engagement.
- Our focus on developing structures for students to receive timely and targeted interventions and support with their learning saw an increase of 22% in students feeling that it is easy to get help with their schoolwork when they need it.
- The student learning priority centred around building a culture of compassionate school practices, to create an environment where all students feel safe and cared for by their peers saw an increase of 18% in students identifying that students help each other at school.
